

Scheduling Tips



- Trips may be reserved up to **14 days** in advance up to the day before your trip.
- Scheduling hours are from 7:30am to 5:30pm, Monday-Friday and 8:00am to 4:00pm on Saturday.
- Same day scheduling is available: *Appointment accommodations are based upon seating availability.*
- Trips are scheduled on a shared-ride basis, meaning the vehicle may stop to let other passengers on or off before reaching your destination.
- When preparing for your trip you should be ready 10 minutes before the expected pickup time. Drivers will wait 5 Minutes after your scheduled trip.
- If you will not be using a scheduled trip please be considerate of others and call 350-9290 to cancel your ride. Cancellations must be made at least 2 hours before your scheduled ride. Failure to cancel trip will result in a "No Show."
- Excess number of "No Shows" will result in suspension of service per GET Policy.

USEFUL INFORMATION

- Service animals are allowed to accompany riders
- Household pets are allowed on vehicles only if they are in a pet carrier.
- A personal care attendant may travel with a Paratransit rider who is unable to travel alone. You must obtain your own attendant and indicate your need for one on your application form. Personal care attendants ride free.
- Eligible riders may travel with a guest. When you schedule a ride, let the dispatcher know if a guest will be accompanying you. The fare for a guest is the same as for the ADA eligible rider.
- Riders are allowed to carry up to three packages, weighing no more than 10 pounds each. Drivers will assist riders with packages.

Monday – Friday: 6:00 AM – 6:30 PM

Saturday: 6:30 AM – 5:30 PM

Eligibility

This service is available to individuals who qualify as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1992 and those who have a barrier to ride fixed route. To qualify, a Paratransit application must be completed. This form is available by visiting:

- GET office at 101 11th Avenue
- Calling GET at 350-9290 and having one mailed to you
- Logging on to www.GreeleyEvansTransit.com and looking under services/paratransit application.

If you qualify for Paratransit service, a picture ID will be issued to you at GET office along with a letter of service guidelines.

Monday – Friday: 6:30 PM – 9:00 PM

Saturday: 5:30 PM – 9:00 PM

Sunday: 7:15 AM - 1:45 PM

There is no service on: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Fares

Individual Fare – \$ 3.00 one way
Book of 20 Paratransit Single Ride Tickets *or*
20 Ride PT Punch Card - \$48.00

Fares must be paid to the driver upon entering the vehicle. Driver does not make change.
